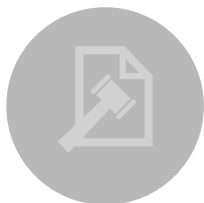

The boot camp aims to provide a framework for the Europe-based companies and entrepreneurs to create a solid foundation on how to expand their business towards Brazil.

The participants will have the opportunity to develop their business ideas within 2 days intensive programme which includes seminars, trainings, and coaching sessions. The particular focus of the Boot Camp is to develop global competences for the Brazilian market and setting up a business in Brazil. Participants will be provided the skills and knowledge in developing their ideas, sustainable business modelling, partner finding and legal advice.

The Boot Camp will be combined with a matchmaking tour to Brazil to connect them to investors, funders and potential partners.

10 companies and start ups will be selected from European countries for this programme through a Call, to be launched in June 2018. The boot camp will take place in Malaga (Spain) in October 2018 and matchmaking tour will be organized in October/November 2018.

Impact of R&I Programmes Training

The main purpose of the training on impact evaluation of R&I programmes is to explore the foundations and recent developments of impact evaluation of policies, programmes, and institutions with respect to research, development and innovation (RDI). The main concepts, methodologies and trends are presented along with cases, experiences and practical application. Specific topics: how to organise and conduct collaborative research and how to evaluate the results; indicators to measuring R&D and innovation activities; cost and benefit analysis; mix of approaches of cases combining methods.

The program is structured around the following main themes:

1. Fundamentals of Science, Technology and Innovation (STI): introduction to the field of STI Evaluation, discussing why it is increasingly important and what their main specificities are. Brief overview of important initiatives of STI evaluation around the world;
 2. Planning and conducting STI evaluation: understanding STI evaluation in Europe; measuring R&D and innovation activities; organise working groups among participants and present them the tasks and dynamics they are supposed to perform as part of the training. Groups will prepare a preliminary set up of an evaluation of a given program/policy/strategy that will be given in this session;
 3. Applied Methodologies: bibliometrics; networks; cost-benefit analysis; institutional impact evaluation; experiments and quasi-experiments; data analysis in evaluation;
- Setting-up an evaluation: presentation and discussion of evaluation setup.
